Subject: Public Records Request.

Dear Ms. Maland:

Pursuant to my rights under the California Public Records Act (Government Code Section 6250 et seq.), I ask to obtain a copies of any and all written or electronically transmitted correspondence, include information that is maintained on paper as well as electronically, such as data files and unprinted emails, between the City of San Diego staff including but not limited to the Development Service Department, the City Attorney and City Council staff and the La Jolla Community Planning Association, it's officers and/or Trustees and Mr. Joe La Cava regarding the proposed bylaw amendment of the La Jolla Community Planning Association (LJCPA) listed as action item number 16.0, and approved by a 8-5-1 vote, on the December 4, 2014 public agenda of the LJCPA (**EXHIBIT 1**). Additionally any dates, time and the notes and minutes of any parties attending meeting between the above mentioned parties to discuss the above mention LJCPA bylaw amendment.

I ask for a determination on this request within 10 days of your receipt of it, and an even prompter reply if you can make that determination without having to review the records in question.

If you determine that any or all or the information qualifies for an exemption from disclosure, I ask you to note whether, as is normally the case under the Act, the exemption is discretionary, and if so whether it is necessary in this case to exercise your discretion to withhold the information.

If you determine that some but not all of the information is exempt from disclosure and that you intend to withhold it, I ask that you redact it for the time being and make the rest available as requested.

In any event, please provide a signed notification citing the legal authorities on which you rely if you determine that any or all of the information is exempt and will not be disclosed.

If I can provide any clarification that will help expedite your attention to my request, please contact me at (858) [REDACTED]. I ask that you notify me of any duplication costs exceeding \$50.00 before you duplicate the records so that I may decide which records I want copied.
